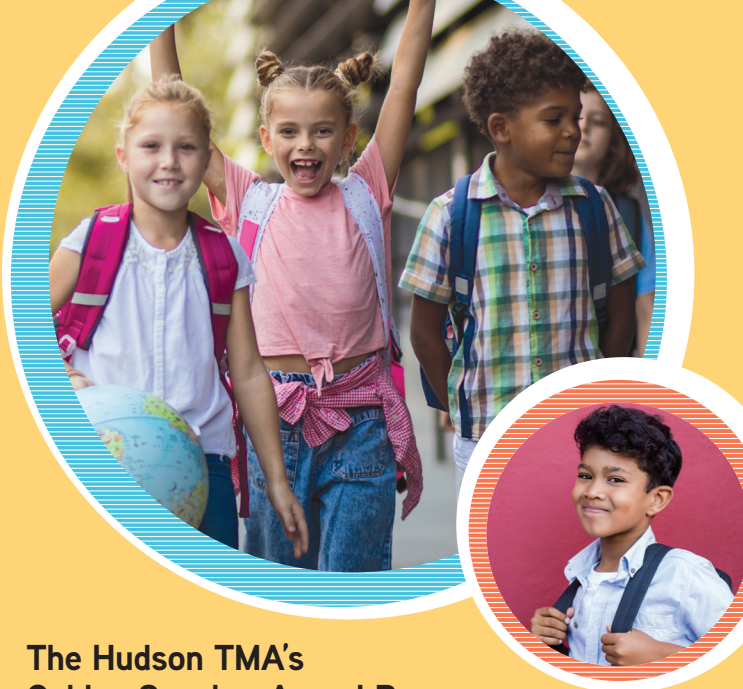




The Hudson TMA's Golden Sneaker Award Program

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Getting Started–It's Simple!

The program runs for 1 week (Monday to Friday), and is available to students in grades 2 and 3 only.

The TMA provides pedometers for students to carry with them to record the number of steps walked during one 24-hour period. Pedometers are loaned to the school free of charge.

During the week, students take turns taking the pedometers home until all the children have participated in the competition.

Each morning the steps taken by the students on the previous day are recorded on a log sheet.

The class in your school with the most combined steps WINS!

An Opportunity for Enhanced Learning!

Teachers can, if they wish, turn the program into an additional opportunity for learning by:

MATH



- Performing daily tallies and additions
- Rank order pedometer readings from lowest to highest

SCIENCE



- Discuss the health benefits of walking
- Calculate distance
- Highlight the benefits to the environment

GEOGRAPHY



- Display on a map the possible destinations the class could have reached with their total steps walked



Additionally, the Hudson TMA offers an interactive presentation to the students when staff members visit the school to award the trophy. This fun lesson illustrates the students' power to save the environment by showing how much carbon was saved just by this walking contest. Students learn that with small changes, you can make a big difference.

Everyone Wins!

The Hudson TMA will reward the winning class with the "Golden Sneaker" trophy, to be displayed in your school, remaining there until next year's competition! All the classes that participate receive an honorary certificate to acknowledge their good walking efforts!
