










# Build Your Own Kite





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1. Measure spars carefully
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
2. Notch ends of both spars
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
3. Tie short spar to spine
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
4. Tie the line around frame
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5. Cut out cover with hem all around
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6. Nick corners of hem to allow turning
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7. Attach cover to frame by turning and gluing down hem
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8. Tie line along back of cross-spar and tighten to bow
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9. Mark 2 bridle points
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10. Create a two-leg bridle
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11. Attach line for launching
