



Make your own PINWHEEL!!!

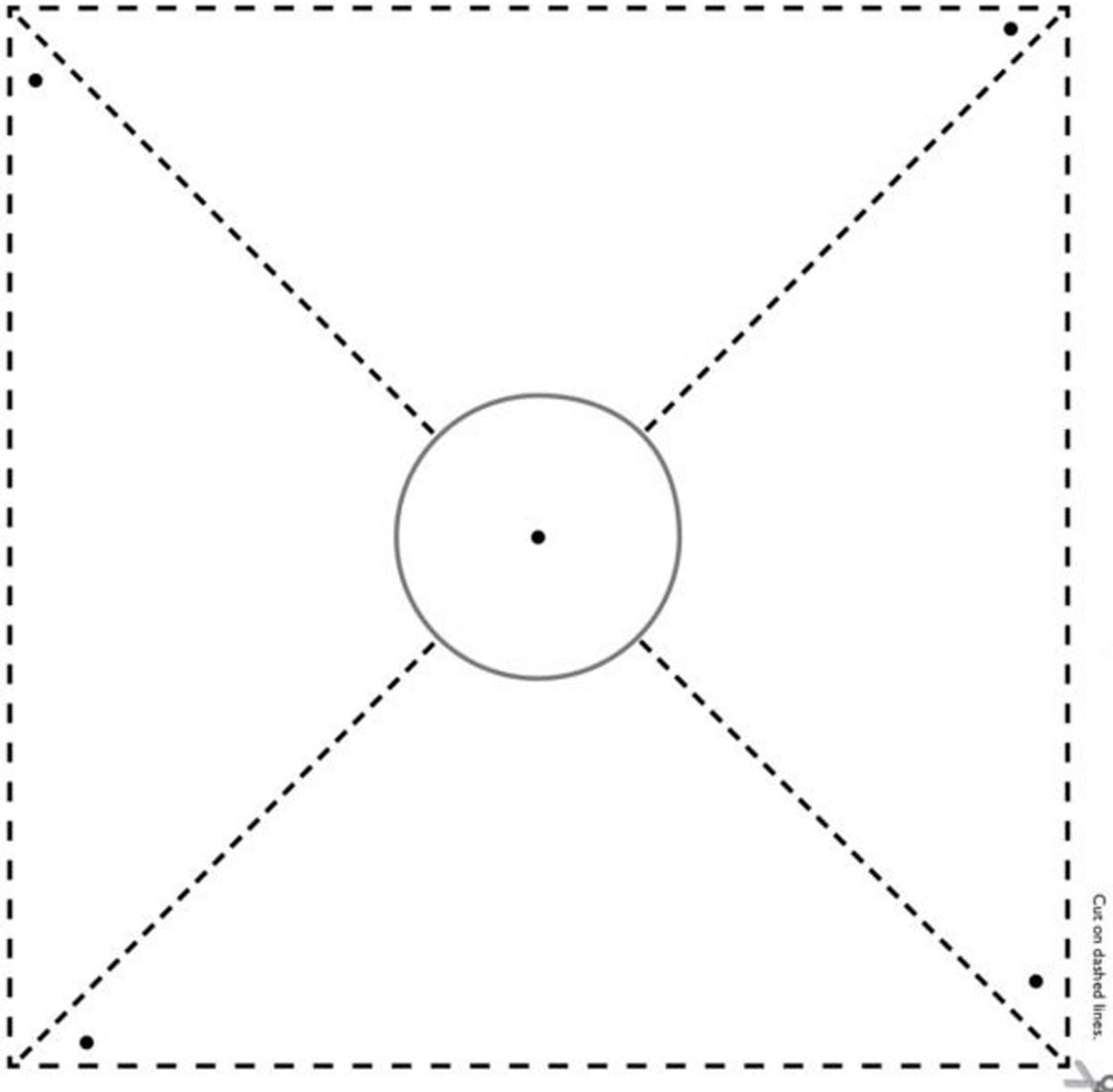
Attach it to your bike or just walk with it!

Materials

- a push pin
- a square piece of construction paper (about 8.5" x 8.5")
- a sharpened pencil with eraser
- scissors



1. Let your child color the front and back of the pinwheel template.
2. Cut out the pinwheel
3. Use the pushpin to poke holes in the center of the pinwheel and in the 4 corners. Twist the pushpin to make the holes smooth. This will help it spin.
4. Stick the pushpin through the corner holes, through the center hole, then into the top of the pencil eraser.. (see diagram)
5. Show child how to blow pinwheel to make it spin!
