# Be Alert!

- If you notice a problem or dangerous condition at a grade crossing such as a car stuck on the tracks or a malfunctioning crossing gate, immediately contact NJ TRANSIT Police.
- Look for a blue sign posted near the crossing that displays NJ TRANSIT's Police contact number (800-242-0236), a U.S. Department of Transportation crossing identification number, and the street name. Report your observations as well as the information included on the sign to the Police.

Trespassing:

Trains Can't Stop  
Quickly!

Trains Can't Swerve!

Watch the gap between the train & the platform



Cross Tracks Only at Designated Locations!  
Never go around crossing gates that are down,  
on foot or in a car!





Be alert of hazards that can cause slips, trips and falls.



Stay away from overhead electrical wires!

Never throw items at trains or onto tracks!





If the walking surface is slippery, try to avoid it. If you cannot, take short, wide steps.

Don't run. Use  
handrails on stairways at  
stations as well as on  
trains.





Watch out  
for others  
who may be  
distracted.

Don't carry more than you can handle, and don't block others.
