

- Alerts pedestrians that something is approaching
- Need to follow the same traffic/safety rules as cars
- NJ State law says this needs to be on the back of a bicycle
- A of the A-B-C quick check so your tires aren't flat
- C of the A-B-C quick check. Check that yours are not rusty or loose
- Use this to help you see if you walk late in you evening
- A person that walks
- Be safe and always walk on the sidewalk as opposed to the street
- A person that rides a bicycle
- Protects your head and brain from injury
- Never wear these while riding-walking-running. You need to hear!
- Always look _____ - right-left before crossing a street
